MCO's ISS Value is Lowered to a 40!

Safety inspectors use the Inspection Selection System (ISS) to select commercial vehicles for inspection. The ISS Inspection value is obtained by the carrier's safety performance.

This performance is based on crash history, inspection history, driver history, and safety management. Once this value is determined, the ISS recommendation is determined.

In July's issue of Currents we reported our ISS value went from 65 to 62. In this

issue of Currents, we are very pleased to announce that our value has decreased again to a score of 40!

Depending on the ISS value, the recommendations vary from inspect (75-100) to optional(50-74) to pass (1-49). The recommendation for our score is PASS.

This score has been achieved through many combined efforts. Keep up the great work and keep these scores low!
