Paperless Driver Logs at Charleston Terminal

Charleston, SC~ In early December our Charleston terminal started their transition from *paper logs* to *paperless logs*. This new system will record hours of service and daily work activities via satellite, and eliminate the drudgery of preparing and handling paper logs.

With minimal input from the driver, this electronic logging system keeps track of drivers' activities and provides them with a readily available, up-to-date resource for managing their time in compliance with hours of service regulations. By alerting drivers when they're running low on available time, the system will not only help them avoid violations, but also offers an invaluable tool for enabling our drivers to maintain a superior level of safety awareness.

Once this transition is completed in Charleston and we're confident that everything is working as it should, we will begin installing the units in trucks at other locations.

We will keep you posted on our progress!



Critical Event Reporting: Hard Braking

Along with the new satellite units, we have new capabilities. One of the new capabilities is the reporting of a 'Critical Event.' In our particular case, most of our critical event reports are the result of hard braking. Once a hard brake occurs, the system sends an e-mail alert to managers and our Safety Department.

The information is instantaneous; the system automatically captures and stores the vehicle's speed for the five minutes prior to the incident as well as the speed of the deceleration.

The Safety Department and your terminal manager will be investigating each of these incidents as they are reported. While we are aware that there are times when hard braking is necessary to avoid a collision, we must also feel confident that our drivers are the safest and best on the road. That means driving at safe speeds, not tailgating, and staying alert.

This new system aids us in monitoring the driving behaviors of our drivers, and affords us the opportunity to help improve individual safe driving habits. In doing so, we hope this new capability will help us prevent accidents before they happen.

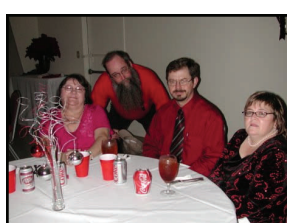
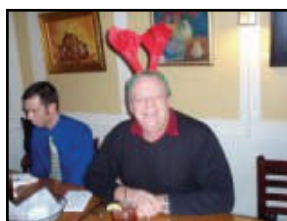
